The Moral Equality of Combatants: Combatants on all sides in a war have the same moral status. They have the same rights, immunities, and liabilities irrespective of whether their war is just. Those who fight in a war that is unjust ('unjust combatants') do not act wrongly or illegally There has been a recent revival of interest in the just-war tradition. But can a medieval theory help us answer twenty-first-century security concerns? The book explores how just-war thinking needs to be developed to provide such guidance.
