KEY CONCEPT The biosphere is one of Earth's four interconnected systems. The biosphere is the part of Earth where life exists. Within the biosphere is a collection of living things called the biota. The biosphere is connected to three other Earth systems: • the hydro sphere, which includes all of Earth's water, ice, and water vapor Biosphere: Biosphere, relatively thin life-supporting stratum of Earth's surface, extending from a few kilometers into the atmosphere to the deep-sea vents of the ocean. The biosphere is a global ecosystem composed of living organisms (biota) and the abiotic (nonliving) factors from which they derive energy and nutrients. The biosphere is made up of the parts of Earth where life exists. The biosphere extends from the deepest root systems of trees, to the dark environment of ocean trenches, to lush rain forests and high mountaintops. Scientists describe the Earth in terms of spheres. The solid surface layer of the Earth is the lithosphere. The atmosphere is the layer of air that stretches above the lithosphere.
