LEAP Speakers - all of whom have worked in law enforcement - write, consult, and meet with advocacy groups, legislators, fellow officers, the media, and the public to craft and support policies that make our communities safer and more just. Step 1: NPOST Exam. All applicants must pass the National Police Officer Selection Test (NPOST) before they can be admitted into the Academy. The NPOST exam is an entry-level basic skills test that helps law enforcement agencies select the most qualified applicants by ensuring candidates possess basic cognitive skills in math, reading comprehension, grammar, and incident report writing.
