1.1.1 This Protocol is primarily designed for personal injury claims which are likely to be allocated to the fast track and to the entirety of those claims: not only to the personal injury element of a claim which also includes, for instance, property damage. It is not intended to apply to claims which proceed under—. The fast track is the normal track for cases falling into the £5,000 to £25,000 bracket, and which can be dealt with by a trial which will not exceed a day.
