

Download Help At The Tabernacle Preschool Lesson

This printable lesson plan is designed to teach preschool aged children about the story of the building of the Tabernacle. It could be used in any setting with children age 2-5 at church, including a preschool Sunday School class or a preschool children's church class. As always, consider your own ministry context and modify it as needed. Children open book and use pencils to trace their hands on inside pages. Then children decorate their hand outlines with markers. (Optional: Children use stickers.) 2. Inside hand outlines, children draw ways they can help at home. ? In our Bible story today, a boy named Samuel helped at the Tabernacle. I love when things work out perfectly.
