SKS M.7.62X39MM BTC S.EL MONTE, CA MADE IN CHINA BY NORINCO 94 XXXXX It also has a POLYTECH mark in front of the lettering. It has a 16.5" barrel and a regular type stock, (not the thumb-hole stock), and accepts double stack AK 47 mags. It does not have the stripper clip guide in the bolt carrier and does not lock open on the last shot. This equals more than 203,000 SKS carbines in their second year of SKS production. This may not be as far fetched as it seems since we know the Chinese are thought to have produced more than 300,000 T53s in 1954, their second year of production and a whopping 440,000 T53 carbines in 1955, only their third year of T53 production!! Norinco SKS has one of the most difficult-to-find manufacturing dates of all the SKS rifles. These guns distributed by Chinese factories are old. What Is an SKS Rifle? It is a semi-automatic weapon that fires rounds that measure 7.62x39mm. A Russian weapons designer, Sergei Gavrilovich Simonov ... All research I've done in the past few hours shows that all SKS' made have a serial number along with a manufacturer, or a factory they were made in (signified by a shape and a number usually), etc.. This rifle only has a five-digit serial number. The LGS said it was a Norinco, but everything I've found has shown that is not possible.
