Proper raw dog food recipes must include one of the following: beef (ground, cheek, stewing) beef heart (but not more than 5% of the diet, since it's very rich) bison (ground or stewing) lamb (stewing, ground, shoulder or breast) pork (cushion, boneless rib, loin, shoulder or butt) chicken (breasts or boneless thighs)
