

Download The Wolf Shall Dwell With The Lamb

The quote the lion shall lie down with the lamb does have its origins in the Bible. However, the saying has morphed over the centuries. Isaiah 11:6 says the wolf also shall dwell with the lamb. The kingdom-of-peace motif has been popular among various so-called Christian "Restorationist" groups. The lamb and lion have been used informally in Community of Christ since the Latter Day Saints' "Kirtland" period. Its original formal iteration, prominently featuring the lion, the lamb, and child, along with the motto Peace, was designed by Joseph Smith III, Jason W. Briggs, and Elijah ...And there shall come forth a rod out of the root of Jesse, and a flower shall rise up out of his root. 2 And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the spirit of counsel and of fortitude, the spirit of knowledge and of godliness. Question: "How should we understand the Lion and the Lamb passage?" Answer: Typically, when someone is thinking of the "lion and the lamb," Isaiah 11:6 is in mind due to it often being misquoted, "And the wolf will dwell with the lamb, and the leopard will lie down with the young goat, and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together."
